Co moved from Wallstede to the town of Ost Dolberg. The enemy was still present when we entered. The town was cleared by the 2d platoon which captured 54 prisoners including one woman in uniform and two officers. 78 Russian POW's were liberated. a patrol from the Co tried to cross the Lippe River at 0530 this morning but found the bridge blown. Defenses were put up to protect the left flank of the Regt.

At 2000 last night, the Co sent one platoon plus tanks to Falkenhagen to assist two troops of the 113th Cav. At 2130 they were ordered to return and go out on a different mission. At 2330, the Co proceeded on foot to Hummersen to capture the town. Arriving there at 0230 they were fired upon by a road block. They immediately returned the fire and entered the town. In the town trouble was encountered with civilians for the first time when a civilian shot a member of the Co. At 0630 the town was officially cleared.

About 1330 a column of enemy soldiers was noticed coming towards our lines. They were captured by the Co at 1340, and when a final count was completed 229 prisoners and 8 women in uniform were accounted for. The Lord Mayor of Zerbst came through our lines trying to arrange the surrender of the town. He was taken to see the General concerning terms. Weather, rainy, but men have good foxholes. Morale, high after mass capture. At 1520, 8 more prisoners were taken.
